The following represent the membership categories of the New York Art Therapy Association and are in compliance with those of the American Art Therapy Association. Please check the category that best describes your position as an art therapist, fill in information below, and submit a check for the appropriate amount by January 1 of each year. The fiscal year for this organization is January 1st through December 31.

CREDENTIALLED PROFESSIONAL: Individuals who maintain current registration (ATR) and/or certification (ATR-BC) through the Art Therapy Credentials Board, Inc. (ATCB). Credentialed Professional members shall be eligible to vote, hold office, serve on committees, and all other rights and benefits provided by the Association. **Dues: \$30**

PROFESSIONAL: Individuals who have completed graduate level training in art therapy. Applicants for Professional membership must provide proof of their graduate degree with their application. Professional members shall have all the rights and privileges granted to Credentialed Professional members. Has voting privileges. **Dues: \$30**

NEW PROFESSIONAL: Individuals who have completed graduate level training in art therapy within the last twelve (12) months. New Professional membership is available for one year only and must be upgraded to Professional or Credentialed Professional in the second year. Applicants for New Professional Membership must provide proof of their graduate degree with their application. New Professional members shall have all the rights and privileges granted to Professional members. **Dues: \$20**

RETIRED: Open to professional and credentialed professionals who are retired from working as art therapists and living on a fixed income. The New York Art Therapy Association includes those retired due to disability and/or serious illness in this category. Does have voting privileges. **Dues: \$15**

STUDENT: Student: Individuals who do not meet the qualifications of Professional membership and who are currently enrolled in institutions of higher learning and are interested in art therapy. Student members must currently be enrolled in an institution of higher learning and must provide a copy of their student ID. Cannot hold an office. **Dues: \$15**

ASSOCIATE: Individuals interested in art therapy and who wish to support the purposes and objectives of the Association. This category is not open to individuals who have completed graduate level training in art therapy or are working as art therapists. Associate members shall have all the rights and privileges granted to Professional members of the Association, except they may not vote or hold office. **Dues: \$30**

INTERNATIONAL: Individuals living outside of the United States who are working in the field of art therapy or are interested in art therapy and wish to support the purposes and objectives of the Association. International members shall have all the rights and privileges as detailed on the member benefits matrix. They may not vote or hold office. Membership is valid from the day that you pay your dues through December 31st for the membership year in which you are applying. **Dues: \$25**

CONTRIBUTING: Contributing: Individuals, organizations, institutions, corporations, or foundations which financially support the goals and purposes of the Association. Rights and privileges of the Individual Contributor shall be the same as those for Associate membership, unless the individual or designee qualifies for Professional membership status. **Dues: \$50**

HONORARY LIVE MEMBER OF NYATA: Honor that is conferred annually by voting membership. Must have been a credentialed professional in good standing. Has voting privileges. **Dues: Gratis.** Year Received _____

PAM CLARK DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD: Honor that is nominated annually by the voting membership. Must be a credentialed professional in good standing. **Dues: Appropriate Membership Type.** Year Received: _____
